##### **Ceramics Open Studio**

##### **Book Making Workshop**

This course will be an introduction to book making. We will be making sketch/ scrap books, or a "travel" book. We will be making paste paper, and hand sewn pages using the Coptic stitch and custom designs. No book making or paper crafting experience needed. Estimated Material Fees \$15 will be paid directly to the instructor, *Stephanie Morris*.
